Dear Friends,

After long preliminary preparations and discussions with our partners and friends in more than 30 countries, Eurasian oncology program was launched in year 2009. So far, three scientific & educational activities were successfully conducted, namely: Eurasian Seminar on Supportive Care in Cancer Patients, April 2009 in Yekaterinburg, Russian Federation; Eurasian Congress on Head and Neck Oncology, July 2009 in Minsk, Republic of Belarus and Eurasian Seminar on Colorectal Cancer, August 2010 in Samara, Russian Federation. In total, so far more than 700 specialists from 35 countries have participated in these events.

Eurasian oncology program was created in order to unite the surgical, medical & radiation oncologists, basic researchers and specialists of other disciplines that are part of the multidisciplinary oncology team from all parts of Asia, Europe and beyond. In spite of the numerous associations and societies of oncologists existing all over the world, communication between specialists from different countries of the Eurasian continent is still a big problem due to the language and cultural barriers, which have not been adequately addressed by any of the existing organizations. Unfortunately, it is not typical for physicians and scientists from different parts of the Eurasian continent to exchange their knowledge, as equals, on a common platform, although most of them are rather experienced in the sphere of oncology. So, there is an acute need for establishing the basement for cooperation between specialists, working in the sphere of research, diagnosis and treatment of cancer patients in Asia and Europe. With the help of this recently launched Eurasian oncology program we are trying to address these needs.

Eurasian oncology program is intended to involve specialists from Europe and Asia in a variety of conferences, seminars for young specialists, seminars and conferences thereby facilitating the exchange of knowledge and experience. The main goal of the program is to address the needs of the most neglected regions of Eurasia, overcoming language and cultural diversity, political and economic inequalities. To make the events fully interactive, all the meetings are held in bilingual format with simultaneous translation to English and Russian languages. In course of time, Chinese, Spanish & French will also become official languages. Specialists working in regions outside the Eurasian continent are also most welcome to take equal participation in our activities.

Only by uniting and joining forces we can get rid of the existing differences and create a unified scientific and practical basis to fight against cancer in the interests of our patients.
